Dear Prospective Vendors:

Below are questions that were submitted regarding the FY 2016 Solicitation for Treatment Services. The answers should assist you in preparing your proposals.

Question No. 1.: What was the awarded pricing for the Oklahoma County Mental Health Contract from 2012-2015?

Answer to Question No. 1: According to the Procurement Management Division, individual project code pricing cannot be disclosed. The total evaluated price of all of the project codes may not be of meaningful use as the estimated monthly quantities(EMQs) have changed.

Question No. 2.: Part 1) In reviewing the RFQ, who has the contract now? Part 2) Are you anticipating the need for a 94 bed facility?

Answers to Question No. 2: Part 1) The Carver Center has the agreement now. Part 2) The U.S. Probation Office is not looking for a 94 bed facility; however, there is a need for a facility that can provide an estimate of 94 units(days) per month. This could mean 3 clients for 31 days per month or 6 clients for 15(units) per month.

Question No. 3: In the new mental health RFP, use of the DSM IV and DSM V is referenced. Are we to use both manuals?

Answer to Question No. 3: As you have identified, there were approximately three references to the DSM IV under certain mental health project codes. Unfortunately, these were typographical errors. Providers should adhere to the newest version of the DSM and will not be held to the DSM IV.
